## ITBS Testing Tips!

As you know next week will be conducting our standardized tests for this year. Please take the time to discuss the following tips with your child insha Allah:

- Read the directions carefully, never assume you know the directions.
- Answer the easy questions first then go back to answer the difficult questions.
- Do not spend too much time on one question, if you find it hard, skip it and come back to it later.
- Answer all questions, and make an educated guess if you do not know the answer.
- Ask the teacher to explain anything that you do not understand.
- You are less likely to make a mistake if you work through the problems entirely.
- Make sure to go back and check your work if time permits
- Go to sleep early the night before and eat a healthy and filling breakfast before the test
- Most importantly - make dua !
