

## **Rules and Guidelines**

**Muhsinoon Donor Solicitation Gift Program Rules:** All donations should be in the form of bank personal or business check, cashier's check, money order, cash or credit card charges. Pledges will not be counted as donations. All monthly automatic withdrawal donations will only be counted at the end of the term of the full monthly withdrawal period. The gift will be withheld until the last monthly installment has been paid. Donations will not be counted if the check is returned due to insufficient funds or due to an account closing. This program cannot be combined with any other Dar-us-Salaam/Al-Huda School program (for example, the ticket competition). Participants must be 16 yrs or older. Due to visa requirements, participants for the Umrah trip must be 19 yrs or older, no exceptions allowed. A 1099 form will be issued by Dar-us-salaam for any gift valued \$600 or more. All donations must be accompanied by the "Donor Solicitation form. The form and the donations must be turned in to the Dar-us-Salaam funding office no later than December 18, 2009. Form and donations can also be mailed at the following address: Dar-us-Salaam P.O.Box 596, College Park, MD 20740. If mailing your form and donations, please allow enough time for it to arrive by December 18, 2009.

**Umrah Trip details:** Participants must be 19 yrs or older; no exceptions allowed. Women 45 or younger must be accompanied by their mahram. Eligible participants in the program will receive a gift certificate for one umrah trip, valued at \$2000. The certificate will be redeemed by Rendezvous Travel, 1800 K Street, NW, Washington, DC, 20006. Phone: 202-659-1919. Any difference in the price of the trip must be paid by the recipient. Dar-us-Salaam does not guarantee the price of the trip to be \$2,000 at the time of booking. This price may change due to travel industry trends. Actual price will be given by the travel agent at the time of booking the trip. Any amount above \$2,000 must be paid by the recipient of the Umrah trip. To receive the best rate, Umrah trip must be booked for travel, between March 1<sup>st</sup> 2010 and June 15<sup>th</sup> 2010. The gift certificate is transferable to another person up to 2 months before the travel, dates: after that it cannot be transferred.

All gifts will be distributed on December 26, 2009 during Dar-us-Salaam's annual fundraising dinner.
